UO Outstanding Research Awards – Deadline Extended

The Office of the Vice President for Research and Innovation (OVPRI), the Office of the Provost, and the Graduate School annually host and sponsor the UO Outstanding Research, Teaching, and Mentorship Awards. OVPRI is currently soliciting nominations for the [Outstanding Research Awards](#). Award categories are: Advancing Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Award, Early Career Award, Innovation and Impact Award, Outstanding Career Award, and the Outstanding Research Career Faculty Award. Awardees receive commendation from the Office of the Vice President for Research and Innovation and \$1,000 for an individual or \$2,500 for a team in research support, a recognition memento, and a highlight of their work in internal and external communications. See the [call for nominations document](#) for full details on the nomination process. The deadline for nominations or self-nominations are due no later than **5:00 p.m. May 6, 2024**.

Changes to National Endowment for the Humanities Summer Stipends Program

The National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) has notified the UO of upcoming changes to the Summer Stipends program for the 2024 competition. The NEH has raised the stipend amount from \$6,000 to \$8,000 and reduced the number of institutional nominations from two applicants to one applicant. These new guidelines will appear in a solicitation to be posted by June 18, 2024. The application deadline is **September 18, 2024**. Interested applicants may attend a webinar on this program to be held on **May 15, 2024**. [Registration](#) for this event is required. UO faculty interested in applying to this program must submit a pre-proposal for review by an internal deadline this summer, which will be published in a subsequent newsletter following the release of the solicitation.

The Limited Submission Process at the UO

This is a friendly reminder to the UO research community about the limited submission process. Limited submissions occur when the funding agency restricts the number of applications allowed by a single institution. All applicants to limited submission opportunities must fill out a [notice of intent to submit](#) form. If there are more interested applicants than allowed, the Office of the Vice President for Research and Innovation (OVPRI) runs a review of pre-proposals to select the best candidates to move forward with application development. Special guidance describes the process when an interested applicant comes to OVPRI within six weeks or less of the funder deadline.
