Re: 2023-2027 F&A Rate Agreement with DHHS

I am pleased to announce that the UO has finalized its negotiations with the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) and that we now have a fully executed facilities and administrative (F&A) rate agreement through June 30, 2027. The full rate agreement may be found on the <u>Sponsored Projects Services (SPS) website</u>.

Under this new agreement, the UO's F&A rates are as follows:

- Organized Research, on campus: **49.0**% (an increase from 47.5%)
- Sponsored Instruction/Training, on campus: **48.0**% (an increase from 46.0%)
- Other Sponsored Activities, on campus: **33.0**% (an increase from 30.7%)
- Off-campus activities: 26.0% (no change)

The following provides guidance as we transition to these new rates:

- 1. The new rates will apply to all new awards and supplements with a project start date of July 1, 2023, or later. An exception to supplemental funding: The National Science Foundation limits F&A rates for supplements to the same rate as the parent award.
- 2. The F&A rate for awards made before August 21, 2023, including non-competing continuations, will remain at the F&A rate in effect when the award was originally made.
- 3. Proposals submitted with an anticipated project start date of July 1, 2023, or later should use the new F&A rates.
- 4. For new awards received with a project start date after July 1, 2023, which included the old F&A rates, the UO will request that the sponsor accept and apply the new rates. Please work with your assigned SPS Sponsored Projects Administrator to address the applicable rates with the sponsor.
- 5. Proposals and awards that have specific limitations on the F&A rate allowed should continue to follow the sponsor's documented guidance and use the maximum rate that the sponsor allows.
