Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA) Defense Science Office issued an annual Office-wide broad agency announcement that invites proposers to submit innovative basic or applied research concepts or studies and analysis proposals that address one or more of the following technical thrust areas: (1) Novel Materials & Structures, (2) Sensing & Measurement, (3) Computation & Processing, (4) Enabling Operations, (5) Collective Intelligence, and (6) Emerging Threats. Scialog® Fellows Program

Research Corporation for Science Advancement [Scialog®](#) program supports research, dialogue, and community building around specific themes to address scientific challenges of global significance. Each theme runs for three years, with one meeting each year held in Tucson, AZ. Each meeting brings together ~50 Fellows across disciplines, with the goal of launching innovative, collaborative, interdisciplinary projects supported by one-year grants of \$60,000 in direct costs per Fellow. For the theme on [Automating Chemical Laboratories](#) (April 2024), submit nominations in **October 2023**. For themes on [Sustainable Metals, Minerals, and Materials](#) (September 2024) and [Early Science with the Legacy Survey and Time](#) (November 2024), submit nominations by **March 1, 2024**.
