Research Funding from the Office of the Vice President for Research and Innovation

The Office of the Vice President for Research and Innovation is currently soliciting proposals for two award programs, open to faculty in all disciplines, with a deadline of **January 14, 2024, by 11:59 p.m.** The <u>Faculty Research Award</u> program provides eligible tenure-track and career research faculty with up to \$10,000 in support for expenses related to research, scholarship, and creative projects. Summer stipends are allowed up to \$7,000. The <u>Research Seed Grant</u> program offers support for individuals (up to \$25,000) and teams (up to \$50,000) for projects that lead to external grant funding proposals that reflect a strong return on investment. Applicants are highly encouraged to consult <u>Research Development Services</u> to determine which program best fits their proposed projects.

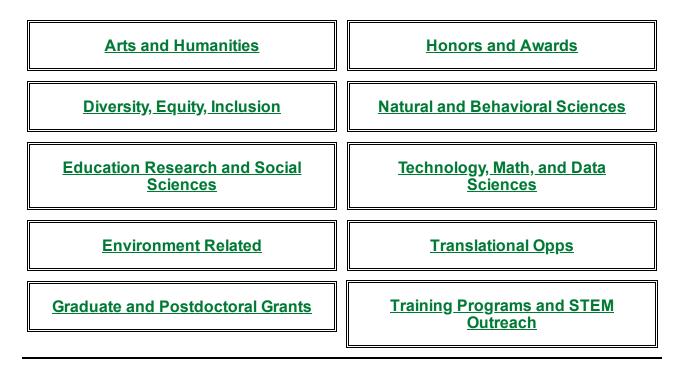
