Reminder: Upcoming Deadline for Research Seed Grant (Revised) and Faculty Research Awards

The Office for the Vice President for Research and Innovation (OVPRI) has added small revisions to the solicitation for the Research Seed Grant program regarding applications for Track 1 (up to \$25,000) versus Track 2 (up to \$50,000). The OVPRI also seeks applications for the Faculty Research Award program, which provides eligible faculty with up to \$10,000 in support for expenses related to research, scholarship, and creative projects. Applicants are highly encouraged to consult Research Development Services to determine which program best fits their proposed projects. Both award programs have a deadline of January 14, 2024, by 11:59 p.m.
