External Peer Review for Proposals

The Office of the Vice President for Research and Innovation offers support for an [external review](#) by a peer in a researcher’s field to identify potential weaknesses in the project’s research strategy and/or methodology. This non-competitive program provides matching funds to contract with a reviewer, who must be either external to UO or emeritus faculty. Faculty in all career stages are eligible, with priority given to early-career faculty submitting their first major external grant(s); mid-career faculty applying for fellowships (particularly for sabbatical), and; senior faculty submitting an application for a major center or other large institutional grants. Faculty interested in this program
