Eligibility for OVPRI Internal Award Programs

Career Research Professional Development Award

Eligible PIs are career research faculty of all ranks at > 0.75 FTE and who have been faculty in UO for one year or more including research assistants, research associates, and research professors.

Faculty Research Award

Eligible PIs are tenure-track faculty members with the rank of Assistant Professor or above are eligible to apply. Career research faculty who hold at least a 0.75 FTE appointment that includes substantial research responsibilities, have been employed by the university for at least three years at the time of application, and will hold a UO appointment during the academic year of the research award may also apply.

Research Seed Grant

Eligible PIs are tenure-track faculty and career research faculty with the classification of research associate, research professor, research scientist, research engineer, principal research scientist, or librarian with 0.50+ FTE appointments during the academic year of the research award.

UO Foundation Trustees Excellence Grant

Eligible PIs are tenure-track faculty and career research faculty with the classification of research associate, research professor, research scientist, research engineer, principal research scientist, or librarian with 0.50+ FTE appointments during the academic year of the research award.
