### Research Seed Grant

The Office of the Vice President for Research and Innovation (OVPRI) announces the 2025 Research Seed Grant competition. This program is designed to provide seed funding to researchers to acquire preliminary data and to develop a competitive proposal for significant external funding. Two tracks are available: Track 1 for awards for up to one year of funding with a \$25,000 award limit, and Track 2 for multiple-investigator awards with up to two years of funding and a \$50,000 award limit. The program's goal is to help researchers prepare for an application to an outside funder. The deadline for applications is **January 21, 2025**.
