Funding Opportunities Newsletter – Updated Subscription Needed for Some Audiences

Starting in January 2025, the Funding Opportunities Newsletter will move to a new delivery system, Mailchimp, to align all OVPRI newsletters on one platform. All tenure-related faculty, career research faculty, unit grant administrators, and graduate students will *automatically* be subscribed under the new system. APLU Webinar: NOAA Leadership on University Funding and Engagement Opportunities

The Association of Public and Land Grant Universities recently hosted the [National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration](#) in a webinar that provides insight into NOAA funding and engagement opportunities for universities as well as the scope of NOAA's research, existing partnerships, and opportunities for first-time applicants. Many of NOAA's research priorities align with UO research excellence (e.g., building a climate-ready nation, integrating equity into core operations, and supporting a new “Blue Economy”). Strategic Investment Funding from the Office of the Vice President for Research and Innovation

The Office of the Vice President for Research and Innovation offers the [Strategic Investment Fund grant mechanism](#) to support and build capacity to position research teams for success in securing major, center-scale grant opportunities, or to create a series of investments (federal, state, philanthropic) in a strategic research area. There are two levels of this award: Track 1 Awards for up to \$85,000 for a project period of up to 12 months, and Track 2 Awards for up to \$250,000 for a project period of 12-36 months. Anyone interested in applying to the Strategic Opportunity Fund should contact [Research Development Services](#) to set up a pre-consultation to determine if this mechanism is appropriate before undertaking significant work on the application. Applications are accepted at any time.
