Sloan Research Fellowship

The Alfred P. Sloan Foundation has announced its 2021 cycle for their [Sloan Research Fellowships](#) for early-career, tenure-track faculty in chemistry, computer science, Earth system science, economics, mathematics, molecular biology, neuroscience, physics, or a related field who also have a teaching assignment. Each department is allowed to nominate up to three candidates—if you are interested in being considered for this opportunity, please reach out to both your Department Head and [Foundation Relations](#) by **July 15, 2021**.

NEH Summer Stipends

The [National Endowment for the Humanities \(NEH\) Summer Stipends](#) program provides awards of \$6,000 directly to faculty applicants for summer research in humanities and humanities-related social sciences. UO is only allowed to nominate two applicants per each grant cycle, and they are selected through an internal review process by faculty peers in coordination with the OVPRI. Should faculty not be funded via NEH, the OVPRI will provide the summer stipend to the two selected applicants. Faculty interested in participating in the 2021 competition must submit a [three-page pre-proposal and two-page CV via this form](#) by **August 4, 2021**. The external deadline for faculty selected for nomination is **September 22, 2021**.

RDS Support for NSF CAREER Awards

The [National Science Foundation CAREER Award Program](#) supports early career faculty with five-year grants for projects that integrate teaching and research. For those working on CAREER proposals, ***RDS encourages you to reach out to this office for application support and proposal critique.*** If you are on a condensed timeline, RDS staff will adapt our feedback and approach based on your timeline and need, including providing copy edits. The application deadline is **July 26, 2021**.
