### Incubating Interdisciplinary Initiatives - OVPRI Grant Opportunity

The Vice President for Research & Innovation invites faculty from all academic disciplines to apply for [2022 Incubating Interdisciplinary Initiatives \(I3\) Award](#). Funding under this program is to be used to successfully develop a novel transdisciplinary line of research that leads to submission of one or more substantial proposals for extramural support for a longer-term project. I3 awards provide up to \$50,000 in funding for a project period up to 2 years. A mandatory [Notice of Intent to Submit](#) is due **February 7, 2022**, and the full application is due **March 7, 2022**.

### Lightning Talk on Fire Science

As part of a new initiative to advance research across Oregon, research development teams across higher education in this state are piloting a new series of virtual Lightning Talks, which will allow faculty from different institutions to provide short, compelling elevator pitches on projects they are leading. Each event will focus on a specific theme. The overall goal of these sessions is to introduce faculty from different institutions and seed potential collaborations. The first talk will focus on fire science--understanding wildfire from social, ecological, or modeling perspectives, creative work or engagement involving fire, public health and wildfire, decision-making around wildfire risk, and more. This event will feature 5-6 presentations (5 minutes per faculty presentation and 5 minutes for Q&A) for a one-hour session. 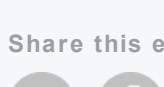
