Onward Eugene

About: We are intentional about being inclusive in our programming and we approach our work through a lens of equity. Onward strives to strengthen the broad entrepreneurial ecosystem by providing a full suite of no-cost programs for companies at all life cycle stages: concept, startup, and growth stage. Our primary focus is on early-stage startups.

Our programs build the pipeline of entrepreneurs by expanding programs beyond the "high growth traded sector" to other small businesses that have growth potential, in partnership with the Lane Small Business Development Center. This includes programs that reach out to communities of underserved populations, specifically women and people of color. Our pre-accelerator and accelerator function as a means of delivering entrepreneurship education through training programs and offer access to mentors, networking, and funding.

We have many programs and educational events that foster entrepreneurship and help people understand how to consider getting started in a small business. We have created an innovation hub at 942 Olive Street that combines a physical space with cross-discipline programs: accelerator programs, an incubator, and launch-stage programs. We have developed a deep pool of mentors that share their expertise at the concept stage through post-accelerator stages. Access to capital is a significant issue in our region, and we continue to build relationships with regional seed funds to focus a portion of their investments in our markets.

Programs: Onward's programs include ID8, which is an 8-week introduction to startup concepts that supports aspiring entrepreneurs craft business models which are ready to develop into detailed business plans.

EUG Launchpad Accelerator: Complimentary to ID8, our EUG Launchpad program helps entrepreneurs advance ideas and business models. Based on the Disciplined Entrepreneur curriculum developed at MIT, the EUG Launchpad program leads participants through 24 sequential steps from the identification of their initial "beachhead" market to their first sales into that market.
