The Catalyst Fund Awards

The <u>Catalyst Fund grant program</u> in the Office of the Vice President for Research and Innovation provides funds to UO innovators for services, tools, and other resources needed to successfully translate their research and launch new UO research-based startup companies. The three funding tiers of the program align with different stages in the innovation and company spinout trajectory. Before applying to any tiers in this program, proposers should have an established relationship with <u>Innovation Partnership</u> <u>Services</u> either through prior consultation, an innovation disclosure, or the incorporation of a UO-based spinout company after pre-approval through a Conflict of Commitment-Conflict of Interest Management Plan. Applications are accepted on a rolling bases and will be reviewed twice a month.

Private Foundation Collaboration Supports "Tabletop" Experiments in Fundamental Physics

The Simons Foundation, the Alfred P. Sloan Foundation, the Gordon and Betty Moore Foundation, and the John Templeton Foundation are inviting applications to a <u>one-time</u> <u>call</u> aimed at advancing fundamental physics by funding small-scale experiments that explore physics, which has typically been explored at large-scale facilities. Each of the participating foundations intends to allocate up to \$1,000,000 per year for five years to fund these experiments. Applicants must submit a brief letter of intent describing the proposed research, which are **due by October 31, 2022**. National Science Foundation (NSF) Regional Innovation Engines Program Seeks Reviewers

The NSF is looking for a diverse group of reviewers representing all backgrounds, technical disciplines, and technology sectors to evaluate program proposals for its Regional Innovations Engines program. The agency is searching for seasoned as well as new reviewers who may have less experience with the <u>NSF merit review process</u> but may have deep experience as practitioners in core focus areas — namely use-inspired research, economic and workforce development, regional innovation ecosystem building, and translating ideas from the lab to the market. Faculty interested in serving as a reviewer must fill out a <u>reviewer interest form</u> by October 7, 2022.


