Pilot Project Data Management Sharing Plan for the NIH

The University of Oregon is part of a pilot project with the Federal Demonstration Partnership (FDP) and the National Institutes of Health (NIH). The project's goal is to reduce the administrative burden for faculty completing the newly required data management sharing plan by minimizing or eliminating variations on the information needed for each NIH institute or center, allowing a consistent format across the NIH. With these goals in mind, FDP and NIH have developed two templates for faculty members to test out when submitting a DMS plan to NIH. These templates are available to applicants via the Office of the Vice President for Research and Innovation website resource on NIH Data Management and Sharing Plans.




