National Science Foundation's PAPPG Announcement

On June 1, 2020, NSF will implement the <u>Proposal and Award Policies and Procedures</u> <u>Guide</u> (PAPPG) (NSF 20-1) for proposals submitted or due on or after this date. But, NSF has made the decision to delay the requirement to use NSF-approved formats for the biographical sketch and current and pending support sections of NSF proposals until October 1, 2020. NSF will continue to implement all other changes to the PAPPG beginning June 1, 2020.

National Institutes of Health - Late Policy on Targeted Proposals

NIH's National Institute on Aging has announced a <u>Late Application Policy</u> for NIAspecific FOAs with application due dates in May, June, and July. Late applications will be accepted by 5:00 PM local time up to two weeks after the application due date for the NIA-specific FOAs listed on the webpage.


