Effective October 5, 2020, the National Science Foundation (NSF) will begin enforcing the [Proposal & Award Policies & Procedures Guide \(PAPPG\) \(NSF 20-1\)](#) requirement to use NSF-approved formats for the preparation of the Biographical Sketch and Current and Pending Support proposal documents. The NSF-approved formats are SciENCv: [Science Experts Network Curriculum Vitae](#) and an NSF fillable PDF. All other PAPPG (NSF 20-1) changes were effective on **June 1, 2020**.
