New NSF Dear Colleague Letter Targeting Graduate Students

The National Science Foundation has issued the [Dear Colleague Letter: Non-Academic Research Internships for Graduate Students \(INTERN\) Supplemental Funding Opportunity](#). Principal Investigators for current NSF-funded research projects may request supplemental funds allowing graduate students to participate in up to two internships periods up to six months in a non-academic setting (e.g., for-profit businesses, non-profit organizations, think tanks, government agencies, museums). Supplemental funding requests may be submitted at any time with a target date of April 15th for each Fiscal Year. A PI on an NSF grant should contact his/her cognizant program director prior to submission.

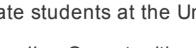
