### NSF Dear Colleague Letter: Research Coordination and Planning Opportunities for the Directorate for Geosciences in Artificial Intelligence

This [NSF Dear Colleague Letter \(DCL\)](#) encourages proposal submissions for conferences and Research Coordination Networks (RCN) that address challenges in the Geosciences that also include and leverage research in Artificial Intelligence (AI). Conference and RCN proposals in response to this DCL should aim to develop collaborations between AI and the geosciences and within one or more geosciences domains. The goals will include:

- \* advancing AI and contributions to research challenges in the relevant GEO domain(s),
- \* advancing domain science by leveraging use-inspired AI research,
- \* actively building the next generation of talent, and
- \* creating a nexus for collaborative research.

GEO is especially interested in research activities that may lead to future successful proposals for the AI Institutes program or for potential future NSF AI investments. Interested applicants should contact the relevant Program Director to discuss whether a proposal may be submitted in alignment with this DCL.

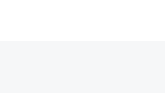
